

1916

Birth of New Sarepta Zion Church as a 'House Church' under the umbrella of the Edmonton Evangelical Mission

Congregation met for Sunday Worship in homes of charter member families

1926

After 10 years the congregation finally had a Church building in which to worship. The Church was built, under the leadership of Rev. A.G. Knopp, on property purchased from the Government (SE 29/49/22). Now known as Rolly View Road and a few hundred metres West of Range Road 224.

1938

A Parsonage was built, under the leadership of Rev. Krotz, in the village of New Sarepta.

Cost of the Lot, Parsonage and small Garage was \$2,600.00

1953 - 1954

The Little Country Church was moved into New Sarepta, in 1953, on the property next to the Parsonage under the leadership of Rev. H. Ginther.

- a full basement was dug
- original church building was extended on east end providing a larger platform, Pastor's study, and small office equipped with a built in desk and gestetner!
- the pointed steeple was replaced with a square steeple
- electricity and oil heat were installed (but still no running water!)
- Dedication was held in 1954

1969 - 1970

Church expansion began, in 1969, under the leadership of Vern Schorr.

- square steeple removed
- a large foyer was added to the West of the existing church
- Sunday School facilities to the North were also added
- 1,256 sq. ft. were added for a total cost of \$14,500.00
- Dedication was held on June 14, 1970

1976

The 38 year old Parsonage was replaced by a modern home under the leadership of Rev. Walter Erion

- Dedication was held August 22, 1976

1978

Large Sanctuary was constructed under the leadership of Rev. Walter Erion

- Sanctuary including Balcony provided seating for 260 people
- additional Sunday School Classrooms added
- new kitchen
- Fellowship area in basement
- Dedication was held on August 13, 1978

1983 - 1985

Another expansion project began in the Fall of 1983, under the leadership of joint Pastors, H. Reinhardt and A. Roth.

- basement was enlarged to accommodate a Fellowship Hall
- main floor enlarged to accommodate 2 Pastor's offices, a Secretary's office and a washroom
- Sunday School classrooms and a large meeting area on the upper level
- 7,600 sq. ft. were added to the main and upper floors plus an additional 2,360 sq. ft. in the basement for a total cost of \$99,310.00
- Dedication was held on August 28, 1985
